

# Gradelink

The parent interface of **Gradelink** provides parents a means to stay up to date with their child's current academic progress, view attendance information, behavior, work study habits, view grades from past terms, and setup email alerts. You should be using **Internet Explorer version 6.0** or higher to access the parent interface. If you have a Macintosh you may also access the parent interface using the latest version of **Firefox**.

To log into Gradelink, you will need to know your school ID (164), your username, and your password. You can get these items from the school office. If you do not have any of these items, you forgot them, or your account is locked, then you will have to contact the school office as they manage all the accounts for your school. To log into Gradelink go to [www.gradelink.com](http://www.gradelink.com) and click on the yellow login link near the top left part of the page. This will bring you to a login page where you can enter your school ID, username, and password.

Achievement Code: The following marks are used to evaluate bold subject areas, responsible behavior and work habits.

- S** Successful: The student is successfully producing work that is consistent with or above grade level expectations.
- N** Needs growth in this area: The student needs to demonstrate more growth towards the grade level expectations for this area

## **Explanation of Primary Level Student Learning Assessment Marks**

Achievement Code: The following marks are used to evaluate bold subject areas, responsible behavior and work habits.

- O** Outstanding: The student is successfully producing work that is above grade level expectations.
- S** Successful: The student is successfully producing work that is consistent with grade level expectations.
- N** Needs growth in this area: The student needs to demonstrate more growth towards the grade level expectations for this subject area.

## **Explanation of Junior High/Middle School Student Learning Assessment Marks**

Achievement Code: The following marks are used to evaluate bold subject areas, responsible behavior and work habits.

- A** The student produces markedly outstanding work, based on a consistently high level of knowledge, skills and understanding of grade level content and expectations.
- B** The student produces work that demonstrates a thorough mastery of the knowledge, skills and understanding of grade level content and expectations.

- C** The student produces work that demonstrates satisfactory knowledge, skills and understanding of grade level content and expectations.
- D** The student produces work that demonstrates limited knowledge, skills, and understanding of grade level content and expectations.
- F** The student produces work that demonstrates unsatisfactory knowledge, skills and understanding of grade level content and expectations.

**Comment Code K-8:** The following marks are used to evaluate the skill areas in each subject.

**+** Plus: The student consistently achieves above grade level expectations in the skill area.

**√** Check: The student needs to demonstrate improvement in this skill area.

No mark given: The student is meeting the grade level expectations for this area.

**Level K-8:** The level at which a student is working to achieve grade level expectations.

Level 2: The student consistently meets and/or exceeds grade level expectations.

Level 1: Individualized Learning Plan/Supplement

No mark given: The student is meeting the grade level expectations for this area.

**I** This mark is given when a student (K-8) has incomplete work due to illness. The “incomplete” mark automatically becomes an **N** (K-3) or an **F** (4-8) if work is not made up in two weeks unless other arrangements have been made by the teacher
